Learner corpora in Sketch Engine

Sketch Engine, a corpus query and management tool, has signed a collaboration agreement with LCA granting its members free access to Sketch Engine to upload, store, analyze and share their learner corpora through the dedicated learner corpora interface.

The Sketch Engine learner corpora interface has been designed to perform analysis based on the type of error, the incorrectly used word or phrase or the correction or based on a combination of these criteria. In addition, any metadata such as the age of the speaker, mother tongue, proficiency level or any other metadata that come with the corpus data can be included into the analysis.



The collaboration agreement with LCA provides its members with:

- a unlimited access to Sketch Engine (for the duration of their LCA membership)
- the possibility to upload their own learner corpora up to the size of 1 million words
- the option to share their corpora with LCA members and other Sketch Engine users

The following functionality is subject to a fee as per standard Sketch Engine price list:

- additional space for learner corpora (1 million included free)
- access to 300+ preloaded corpora in 85+ languages
