criteria for the same token/position must be inside a pair of square brackets (?1) is a switch for case **in**sensitive matching. All characters that follow will be matched whether upper-case or lowercase, including NEW, NeW or neW.

Regular expressions are used to search or match strings of characters such as words or tags. In CQL, they can only be used inside the quotes. Regular expressions are always case sensitive, i.e. **A** is different from **a**.
